Palm Sunday/ Sunday of the Passion April 9

This year, the Worship & Music Committee is inviting everyone to bring some greenery from your garden to wave during the Palm Sunday procession.

The origin of waving branches on Palm Sunday goes back to the description of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. When we actually read what it says, it is interesting to note that what the people are actually doing is creating a "red carpet" for Jesus, and that the branches

were actually supplementary to people's own clothes in creating that "royal processional way."

Matthew 21:8 says, "Most of the crowd spread their garments on the road, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road." Mark 11:8 says, "Many spread their garments on the road, and others spread leafy branches which they had cut from the fields." Luke 19:36 says, "As Jesus rode along, they spread their garments on the road." But John 12:13 says, "So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him." As you can see, our tradition of waving palm branches favours John over the other three Gospels.

But in our procession, we are not welcoming those who may happen to be in the procession that begins the service (in our case, the choir), we are remembering the event described in the Bible. So we do not lay out a "red carpet" of branches, but

rather wave branches as an expression of worship, hailing the entry of Jesus Christ into the Jerusalem of our hearts.
